Another rock trip has been added to the Arizona Rock Hound website.

The JC Holmes Mine is easy to get to within a  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile of the site in any vehicle. February 2016 any vehicle could do the last  $\frac{1}{4}$ . When I was there before the last  $\frac{1}{4}$  was a challenging 4x4 only section. This collecting area is in Southern Arizona in the Santa Rita Mountains near Patagonia, Arizona which is 2.5 to 3 hours south of Phoenix, Arizona. The primary material collected here are vandanite specimens. Hard rock mining will yield impressive specimens. Small Quarted sized pieced are abundant in the rubble. The mine is located on a very steep hillside. Caution is advised as the rubble at the collecting area is extremely unstable.
