The Table Mesa site just off of I-17 is popular with many rockhounds as it is so close to Phoenix. It was an easy trip that could be made in any vehicle; however the roads have deteriorated badly. Therefore, a high clearance or preferably a 4X4 vehicle is now recommended for this trip.

I revisited this site after hearing that a group from a Phoenix area Rock Club was informed that the site was closed due to Bald Eagle Breeding nearby. I researched this and found information on the [Maricopa County Website](#) including this [closure area map](#). The track to the site comes no closer than 2 miles from the closest limited access area and over 5 miles from the nearest part of the restricted area.

The Bald Eagle Closure is typically in effect from December 15 - June 15 each year. If you go during that period, you may want to take a copy of the map.
